

BOYS' FINALS - March 5th (Wednesday)

The two first-place teams will playoff for first and the second-place teams from the preliminary round will playoff for 3rd. Games will be held at QJS starting at 3:30pm March 5th.

1. Divisional Games, Playoff Games and Final Games will consist of 4x8 minute quarters. Clock stops on time-outs and substitutions, only. *Each team will be permitted 1x 60 second time-out per half, and one additional time-out per overtime period.*

Overtime periods will be 5 minutes, running time, in duration.

Division Tie-Breakers:

- 1. If two teams tied with same record, the winner of the division match between these teams will be the division winner.
- 2. If three teams tied with same record, then the team that has scored the most points vs. the other tied teams will be the division winner.
- 2. **First** will be awarded to the team with the best record against the other two teams. If two teams are tied, the winner of the playoff match between the two teams will be first. If all three teams are tied, the team which has scored the most points vs. the other teams will be the champion; **second** and **third** determined the same way.
- 3. **Note that**: Foul shots are not awarded. If fouled in the act of shooting, one point and possession on the end line in the offensive zone are awarded. If the shot scores, the regular two points and possession on the end line are awarded. Players are ejected on their fifth personal foul.
