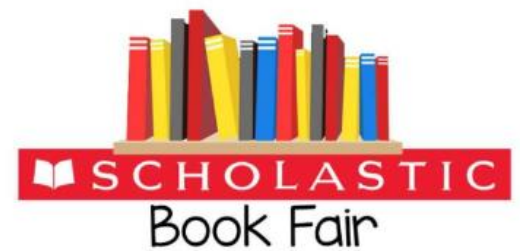
École Red Bluff/Lhtako Elementary April 2026 Newsletter
