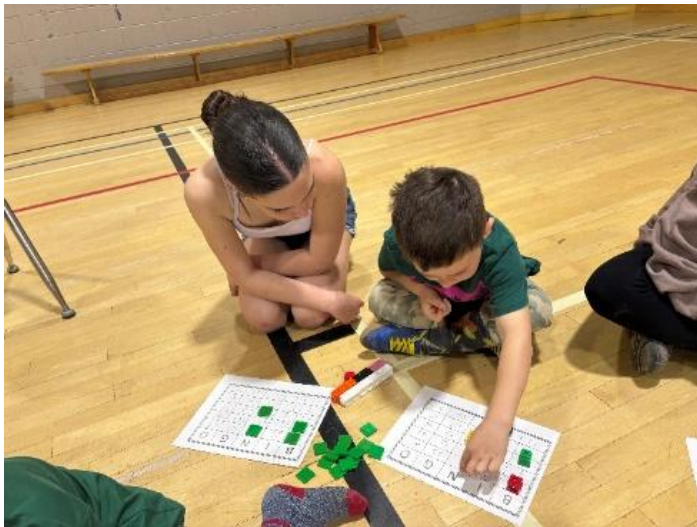


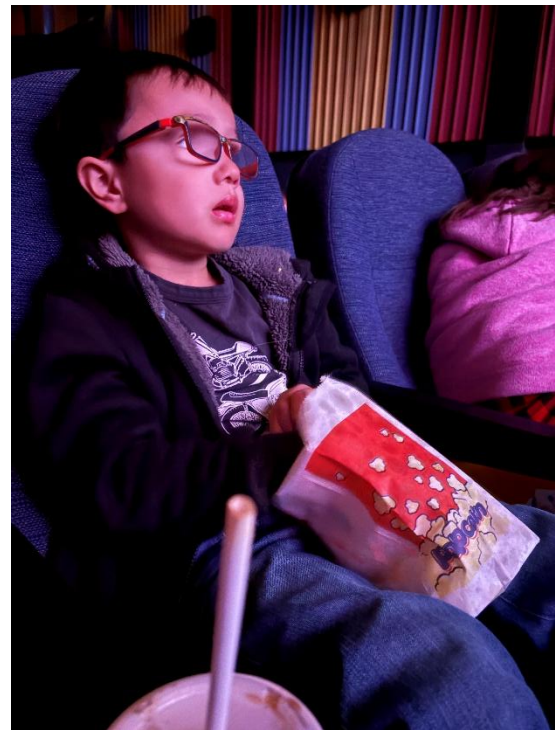

French Immersion Week

French Immersion week was an incredible experience for our students! French Immersion students from Kindergarten to Grade 11 enjoyed watching Zootopia 2 in French at the Carib Theatre on April 23 and dancing and singing to French country music with Éloïz on April 27. Éloïz is a famous French country singer who has been on a tour of French Immersion schools across our province.

These are the countries that French Immersion classes shared facts and foods with English divisions: Belgium (K), Switzerland (K/1), St-Pierre-et-Miquelon (Gr 2), France (Gr 2/3), Djibouti (Gr 4/5), Cameroon (Gr 6/7). Students learned about how French is spoken in different parts of the world during our assemblies, class sharing time and in the scavenger hunt!
