All grade 7's will be attending QJS on June 22nd for Orientation Day. More information will be provided closer to June 22nd.

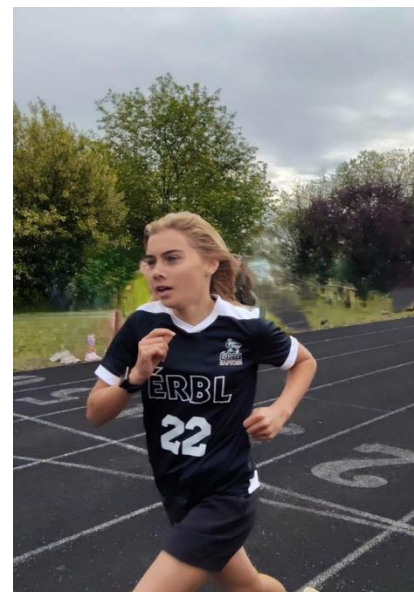
